Dearborn, MI. May 21, 2024 – Friends for Animals of Metro Detroit's PAWCHELLA, presented by Rande and David Wright, is a three-day festival, June 21 – 23, celebrating the human-animal bond, while raising funds for over 2,500 animals cared for by Friends for Animals each year. The festival will be held outside the MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center, located at 16121 Reckinger Rd. in Dearborn. There will be something fun for everyone: contests and activities for dogs and their humans, face-painting and strolling magic for kids, six bands in two days, shopping, raffles and so much more!

Friday, June 21, the adoption center transforms into an outdoor concert venue for the "Artists Unleashed" Concert, presented by MaryAnn Wright and Bob Sayles. Doors are at 6:45 p.m.; and Nashville-based opening act, Trey Taylor, goes on at 7:30 p.m.; followed by songwriter Darcy Moran; Lester., fronted by Celeste Jones, part of the Friends for Animals medical team; and headliner, Danny VanZandt.

Enjoy the Bottoms Up N' More mobile bar, four bands and the Kona Ice, Chokes Grille and Bakri Coffee trucks.

Saturday, June 22, partake in family fun, including a pack walk with your pup from 9 – 10 a.m., Bakri Coffee, What's Up Dawg?, Street Scoops, Cooking with Nada K., and Paco's Tacos food trucks; two more bands, West of Windsor returns for the early time slots, while local party band Sunglasses After Dark closes out the afternoon; contests, featuring Michigan State Representative Erin Byrnes and Dearborn Council Member Kamal Alsawafy as judges; raffles; and exhibitors. WHFR Henry Ford College radio will be running a live stream all weekend from the event.

There will be a corn hole benefit fundraiser tournament with upper and lower divisions, starting at 1 p.m., with registration at noon for \$50 per team.

You can also try your hand at dunking Council Member Alsawafy, and other local heroes, such as Silvio Davis, in the fundraising dunk tank.

Make sure to be prepared to sign up for this year's contests at registration, which will include:

Enjoy more vendors and a bake sale on the final day of the festival. This event will be free and open to the public.
